1. Built-in Dynamics NAV report designer



Microsoft Dynamics NAV has always had its own report designer coupled with the Visual Studio (VS) report designer allowing NAV Developers to access the data and present it in ways that suit your specific business needs.

2. Account Schedules



Analyse data from the General Ledger, Sales and Purchase, and Inventory. Compare this data to Budgetary figures entered in the system across Time, Departments, Projects, Campaigns, and Other Dimensions. The

easily defined Line and Column layout provides users with a comprehensive and tabular form of analysis. Results can be presented in Print, Onscreen - from which users can easily navigate to original entries, and in Microsoft Office Excel for further processing.

3. Analysis views



Gain a comprehensive understanding of the business and its activities with this multilevel and multidimensional business insight capability. Create analysis views for different purposes. For example, users can

see an Analysis View relating to sales in a particular area for a particular time period and for a particular group of customers. The views can easily be sent to Microsoft Office Excel, where the automatic creation of relevant PivotTable views enables users to drag fields and use additional measures, dimensions and criteria.

Jet Analytics takes this one step further and allows you to run a Data Warehouse with connections across different programs and Live reporting.

5. Power BI



Power BI, a self-service business intelligence solution delivered through Excel and Power BI Desktop makes use of tools that non-technical business users can easily use to expand their BI capabilities within their businesses.

Connecting Power BI with Microsoft Dynamics NAV allows for easy integration and reporting into Microsoft Excel, leveraging the tools in the PowerBI suite like PowerPivot, PowerView and PowerMaps. Power BI is also available as an app to plug into with Dynamics 365 Business Central and reports can be surfaced in a user's Role Centre. Connecting your data with Power BI is a simple process allowing users to be set up and running with reporting solutions quickly.
